## Wednesday, July 8 LCC and LVSM Chamber Partner To Initiate Summer Teen Art Camp

**LCC/LVSM Teen Art Summer Program Is A Model For Future Youth Education and Recreation Programs Being Designed To Enhance Family Life and Promote A Healthier Sustainable Community**

As part of it's new membership services initiative, the LVSM Chamber of Commerce has partnered with Luna Community College to create an educational enrichment program for teens this summer.

From July 12th through the 16th, teens ages 13 to 18 can sign up for one week of afternoon classes, Monday through Friday at LCC.

The five day camp is called "The Art of Business," and is designed to introduce students to the world of art and the diverse range of styles and genre that artists use to create their works.

This years teen camp will showcase mixed media-collage, whimsical funky painted chairs and wire-bead sculpture.

Students will also receive an overview of the business aspects of the art trade, from the cost of the initial investment in materials to creating a finished product to sell. All completed student works will be displayed at the 175th Anniversary Celebration for the City of Las Vegas in September and auctioned. Students will receive 100% of the retail sales price.

If this project is successful the Chamber of Commerce is proposing to develop future teen recreation, art and business programs year round.

Teens should register early to sign up for their preferred project of choice, since only twenty students will be accepted in this years camp.
